## 1

When you arrive at the Sydney Opera House, you will travel across the Forecourt.

The entry to all venues is underneath the monumental steps. Head toward the area where the star is.



## 2

There is some construction on the Forecourt.

There may be barriers around areas where people may be doing noisy works.

Follow the signs. There will be staff to assist.



# 3

Under the monumental steps it is shaded and a bit darker.

There will be a queue line set up before you enter the building.

Staff will be available to assist you.



# 4

Follow the queue around using the ropes as a guide.

In the queue you will step through an electronic gate. This gate checks for metal items that you might be wearing or have in your bag.



# 5

Staff may do a bag inspection.





# 6

Enter the Western Foyer doors.



# 7

There are bathrooms at the top of the Western Foyer.

There is also a Changing Places facility located upstairs in the Main Box Office Foyer if required.



# 8

The Playhouse Theatre is at the top of the Western Foyer.

The entry doors are on both sides of the cloakroom and the Box Office.



# 9

The theatre doors will open 15 minutes before the show. There may be a queue to enter.



# 10

The Sydney Opera House staff will scan your ticket.



# 11

The theatre space will be a bit darker than the foyer.

Walk toward the row and seats that you have booked.





# 12

You will see a set on stage. The actors will be waiting backstage. When the show starts, the theatre will get darker, lights will come up on stage and the actors will appear.
