Welcome Team staff wear orange shirts.



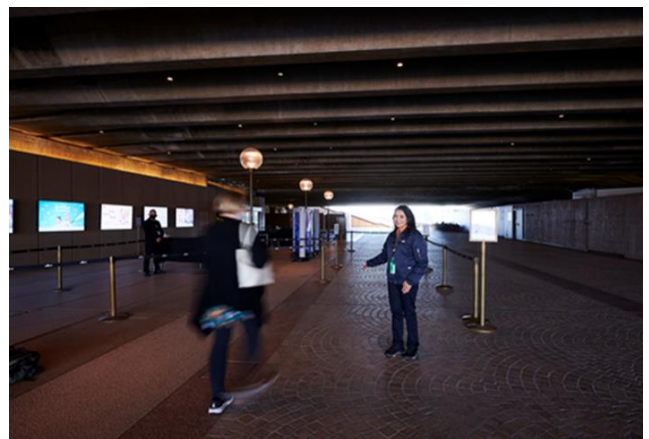
Security staff wear blue uniforms.



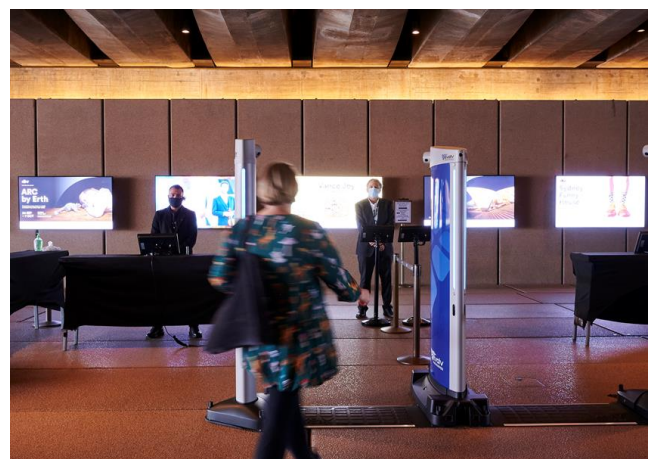
Front of House staff wear blue and beige uniforms.

Staff may do a bag inspection.

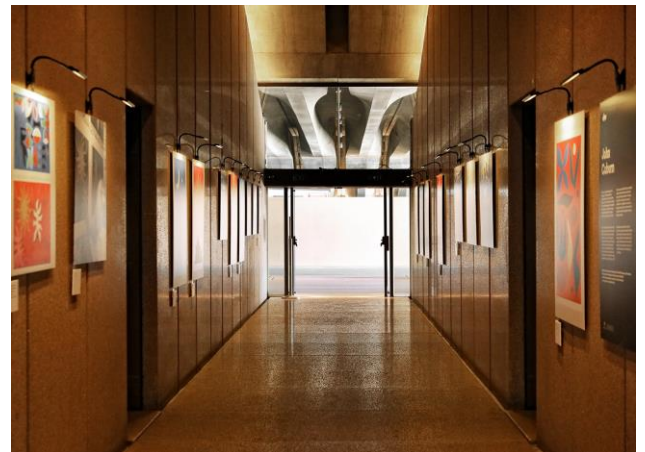
Security do these checks to keep everyone safe.

I can use the bathroom which is next to the quiet space.

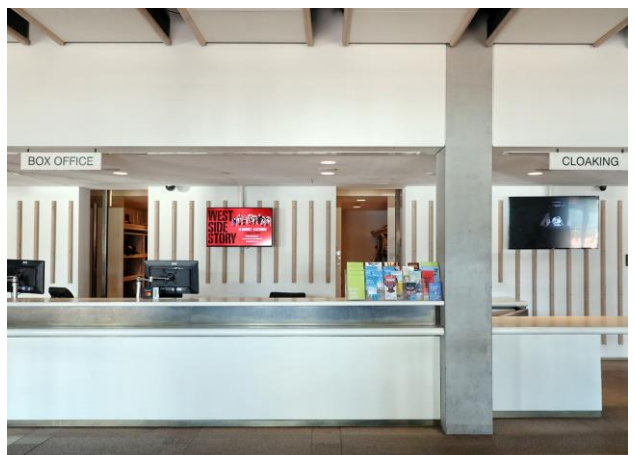


The Western Foyer is past the quiet space and bathrooms.
