Staff may do a bag inspection. Security do these checks to keep everyone safe.



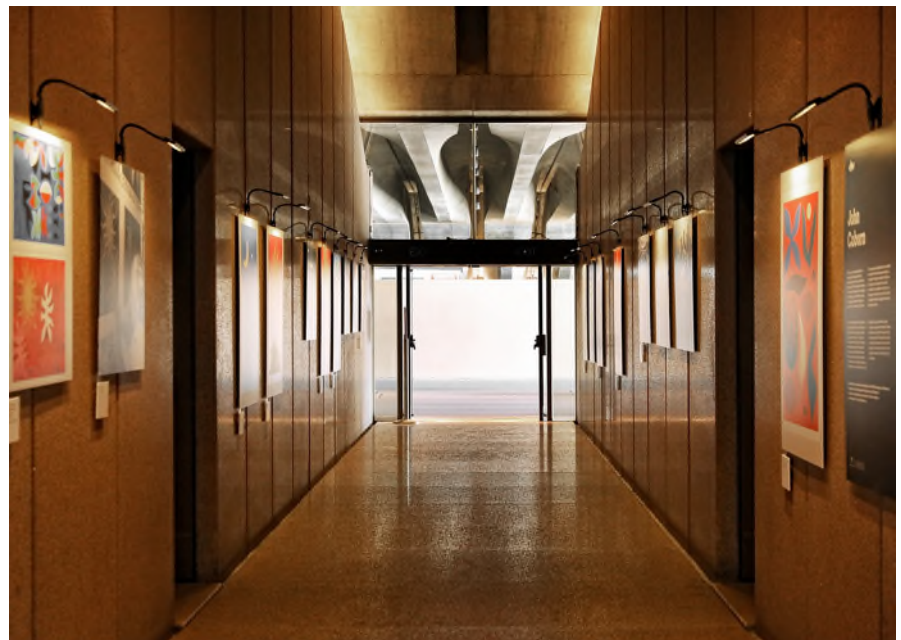

I will enter the foyer doors at the end of the queue.



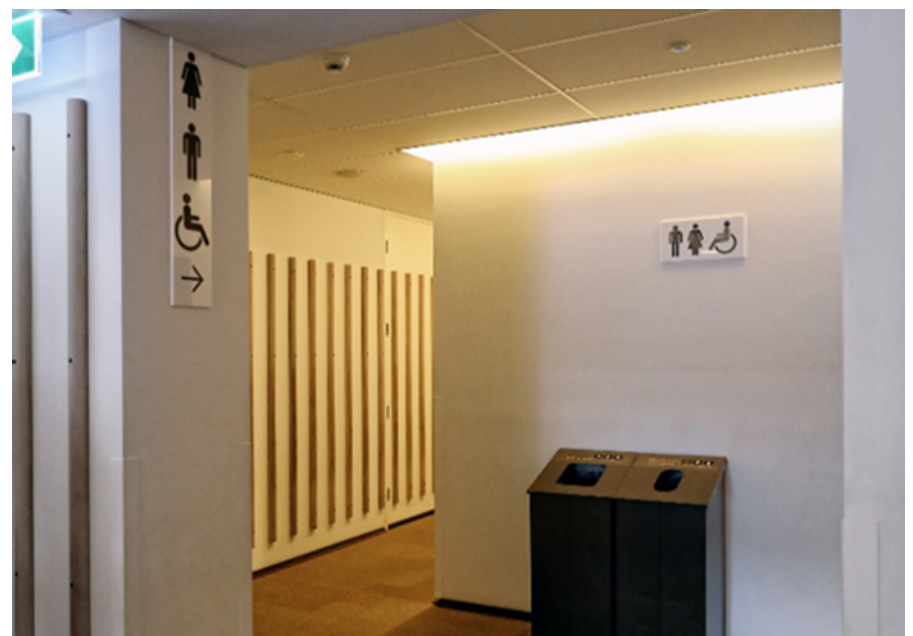

I can use the bathroom at the end of the corridor on the right.



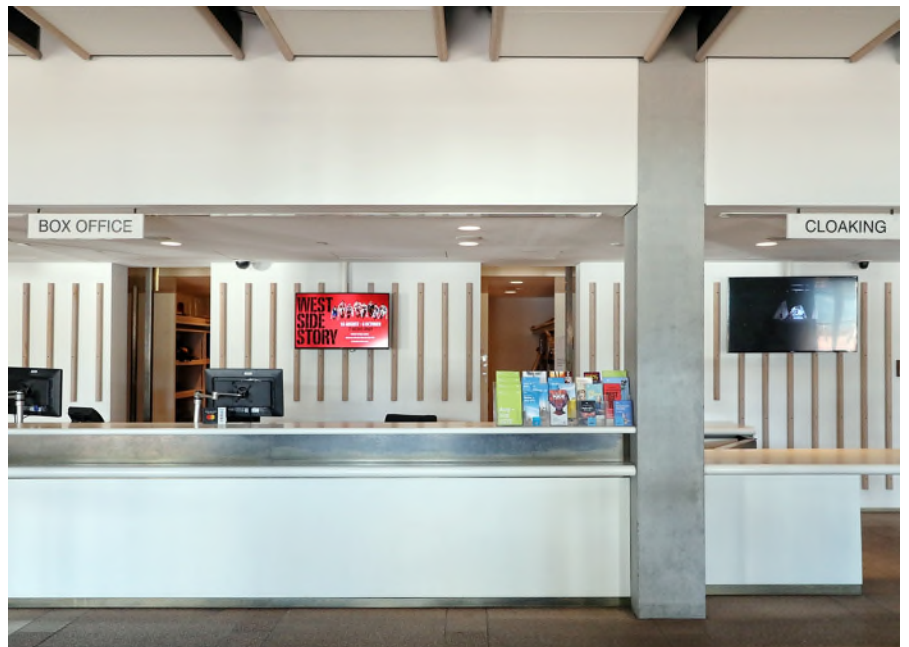
