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To what extent is the show dialogue / music driven:

This is a musical and is primarily driven by musical sequences, tied together with short dialoguedriven scenes.

Are audience members expected to read text within the performance:

There is a poem projected as part of the Acknowledgement of Country but the audience is not expected to read along. The characters collect letters of the alphabet during the show, and later the alphabet is projected onto the backdrop of the set.



Theatrical Effects and Sensory Information

Does the production include:

AUDIO	
Loud volume audio/music	Nothing too loud, but this is a musical so there is a soundtrack to the show
High-pitched tones	Some excited sounds from Nanna when she is surprised or frustrated.
Unexpected sounds	Clap of thunder during a rain scene and some bird sounds when a small flock of seagulls (puppets) enter the stage.
Repetitive noises	Some repetition in songs. There is a light drumming sequence (utilising the timber sides of the bus, the bus horn, and hand clapping. One other scene sees bins used like drums but the sound is not surprising or too loud.
Drums	See above. Drums are utilised in some of the musical numbers.
