Welcome Team staff wear orange shirts.




Security staff wear blue uniforms.

Staff may do a bag inspection.


Security do these checks to keep everyone safe.




I will enter the foyer doors at the end of the queue.



I will walk down the corridor.




I can use the bathroom at the end of the corridor on the right.

The Playhouse entry is next to the Box Office.




I can take a water bottle into the theatre.
