A small bag is OK to bring into the theatre. Any bag larger than an A4 piece of paper can be cloaked at the cloakroom.






When I arrive at the Sydney Opera House, I will head toward the bottom of the staircase.

When I arrive, I may see a line of people. I will join the back of the line.








Staff will be able to assist me if I need help.

You will step through an electronic gate.






Staff may do a bag inspection.

Security do these checks to keep everyone safe.






At the end of the queue turn left and enter the Western Foyer doors in front of you.

You can see these doors from the queue line.






When I enter the Western Foyer there are toilets to my right.

The Playhouse Theatre is the closest theatre to the entry.






The theatre doors will be open 20 minutes before the show.

I will walk toward the row and seat that I have booked.

Music will interrupt some of the stories Josh will tell.
