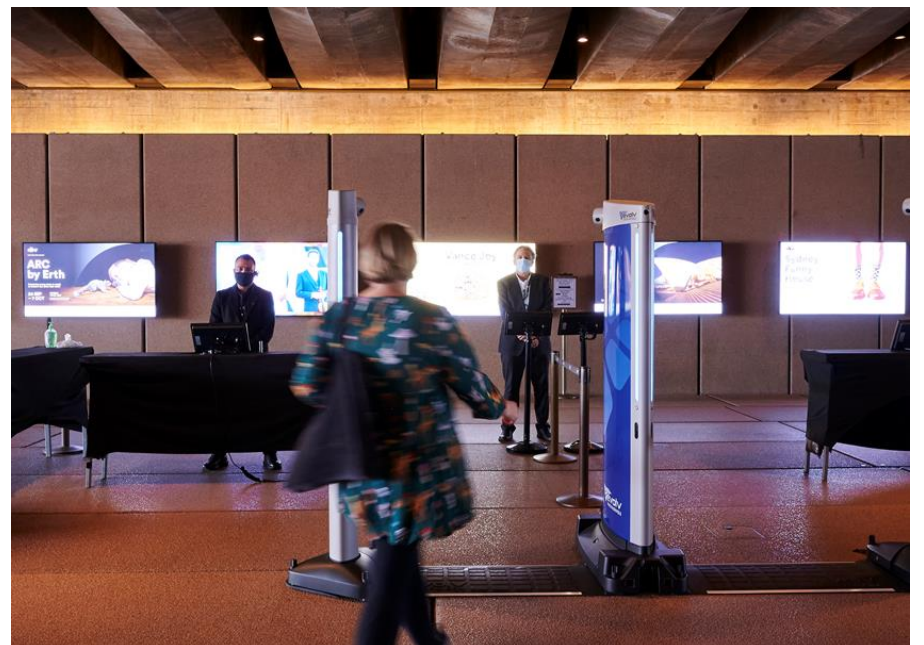

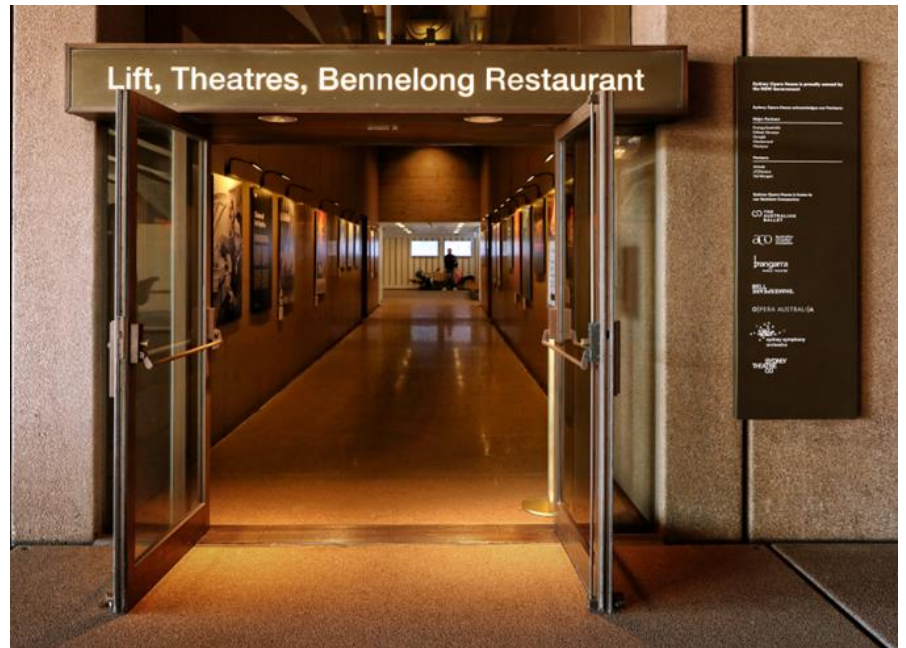

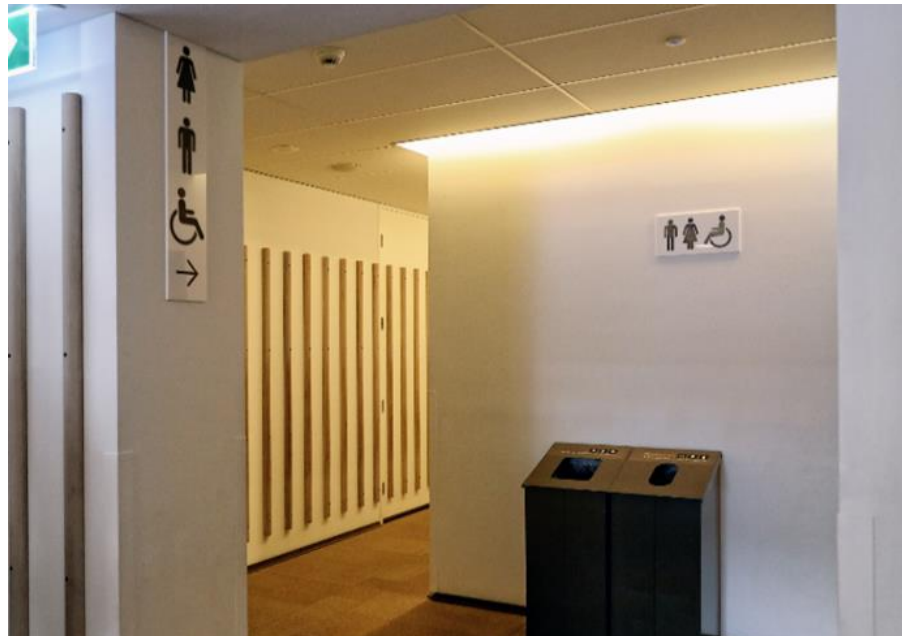

There are seats outside the Centre of Creativity and a bathroom



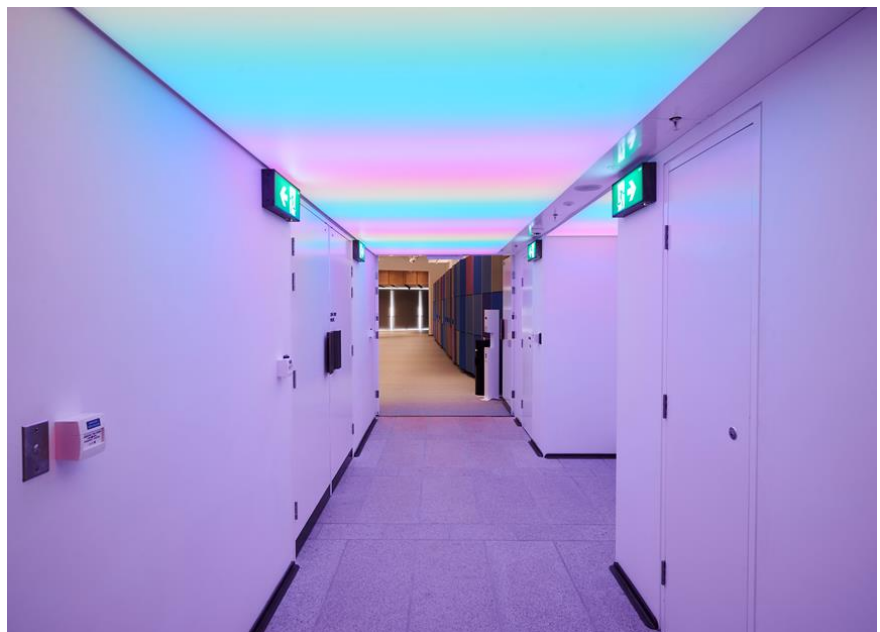
